- Host Brazilian visitors;
- Identify opportunities for Visiting Scholars and researchers from Brazil.

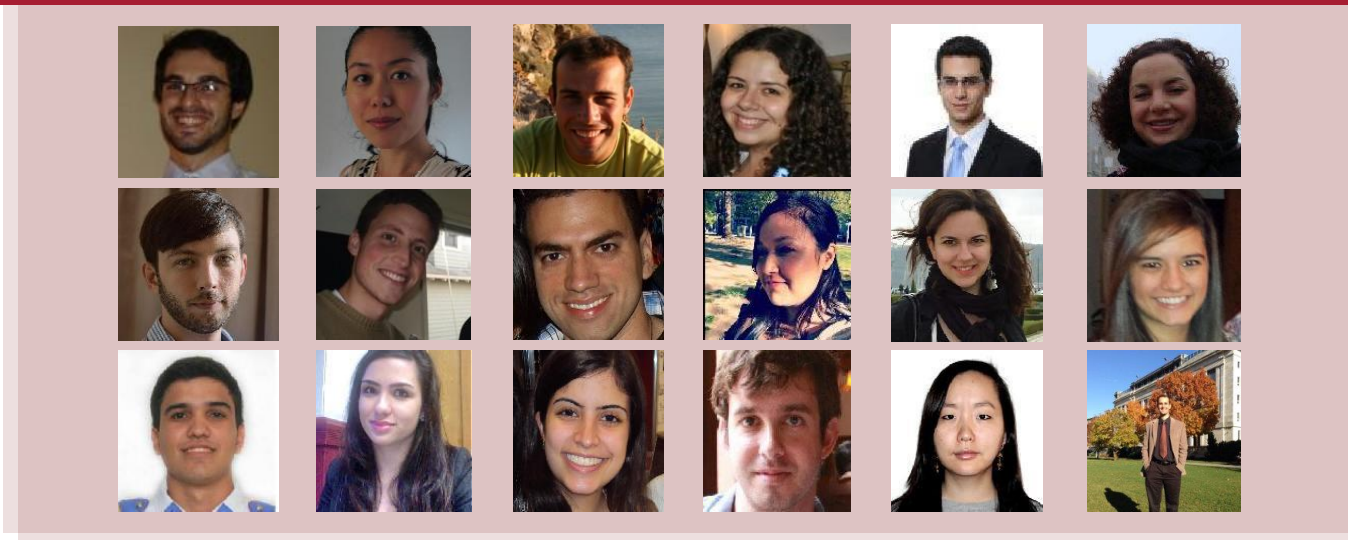
